

How to schedule 48-281 (Methods) & 48-282 (Applications)

Sign-ups for Methods & Applications are held approximately 4 weeks before scheduling begins in the Psychology Department office, 2102 McCormick. Signs will be posted on the second floor of McCormick and faculty will make announcements in class. You **must** have Psychology declared as a major or minor or you **will not** be scheduled for these classes.

Students will be scheduled for these classes according to the following timetable:

Priority #1 - Those students who have **already met** the prerequisite requirements will be scheduled according to the scheduling timetable.

Priority #2 - Students who are **currently** taking the prerequisites will be scheduled at the end of the semester **after** grades have been verified.

Priority #3 – **If** there are seats available after scheduling priorities 1 and 2, students who are **repeating** the course or **withdrew** from the course in a prior semester and have “sat-out” a semester, will be scheduled.

NOTE: Due to the limited number of seats, it is possible that not all students who have signed up will be scheduled.

STUDENTS **WILL NOT** BE ENROLLED IN THESE COURSES UNTIL THEY HAVE MET **ALL** PREREQUISITES.

Important: The maximum number of times Methodology may be repeated is 1.
